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Know your rights

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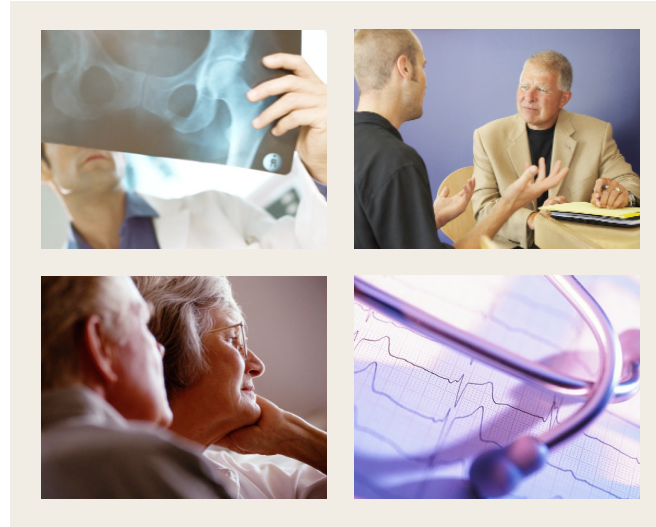
If you've been injured through the carelessness, negligence or irresponsible behavior of a physician, nurse or other healthcare provider, you may be able to obtain compensation through a medical malpractice lawsuit. Legal action may be the only option when a medical care results in harmful:

- Misdiagnoses of diseases or conditions
- Surgical errors
- Medication administration errors

What happens in a medical malpractice case?

Individuals found by the courts to be responsible for medical malpractice are required to pay damages, which are generally paid by the healthcare worker's insurance provider. If your case is successful:

- A settlement will be determined by negotiation or the decision of a judge or jury.
- You may be awarded actual damages for pain and suffering, healthcare, lost income, mental stress, and permanent disability, among other things.
- You may also be awarded punitive damages, or funds over and above actual damages, if the defendant's behavior was especially reckless.
